Boatswain Park: The request for quotations will be distributed in the near future.

Cobble Hill Common: It is quite muddy and still draining onto the road. A comprehensive Cobble Hill drainage study is in the works.

Hatch Point Trail: An acknowledgement of Chevron's contribution is being prepared by Staff.

Off Leash Dog Park: Director Clement will speak with staff and by-law enforcement to ensure any dog deemed vicious will not be permitted to enter the dog park, even if it is muzzled. All parks in the CVRD require dogs to be leashed including the Regional Recreation Area of Cobble Hill Mountain.

Cherry Point Parking lot requires grading.

Heritage Church: The Historical Societies of Bamberton, Mill Bay Malahat and Cobble Hill have expressed an interest in using the church as a museum.
